2023 Mission Plan (to be reviewed February 2024)

This plan looks again at the vision and mission of the church in New Sawley following the impact of the Covid Pandemic of 2020/21.

1. Develop a Culture of Prayer and Discipleship

- To continue to hold a monthly coffee morning, actively inviting those outside of the church to attend.

- Plan a fun morning/afternoon for children with refreshments for parents and carers. (July/August 2023)
