*In advance!* Ask everyone to bring a candle - any shape or size will do - birthday, tall, short, colours, scented. Have a few spare candles handy, & a means of lighting them.

It's ok if you have none because I then share some of mine when you press play/continue. I wanted people to have opportunity to interact a bit with me and each other.
